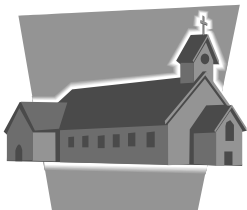

**Liturgy Notes**



*Liturgically we are in Ordinary Time.  
Why is it called Ordinary Time?*

...Ordinary Time refers to the ordering or counting of Sundays...recognition of our human need for time to grow in the understanding of the mystery of the Incarnation. We recall the psalmist's prayer that learning to number, or count, our days can lead us to wisdom (see Psalm 90).

It is in the Spirit that we understand Ordinary Time: we are given a period of time to learn more about Jesus' life, to meditate on the meaning of the Gospel for our lives today, and to practice our Christian vocation to be Christ in the world. 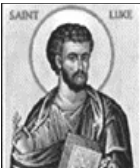


